



GJHSA is approved for APHA PAC Program

The Grand Junction Horse Show Association (GJHSA) was approved to participate in the 2013 American Paint Horse Association (APHA) Paint Alternative Competition Program (PAC) by offering to registered APHA owners and exhibitors the chance to earn **CREDITS** for participating at any of the five GJHSA Open Horse Shows in 2013.

Even though APHA is not officially associated with these events, the APHA does want to recognize APHA registered owners and member's efforts on your American Paint Horse. As a result, your accomplishments can be recorded on your registered horse's official lifetime performance record through the APHA PAC program.

To participate in the PAC program:

1. Submit a completed PAC enrollment application along with required fees to the APHA at <http://www.apha.com/programs/pac> before you can participate.

Once you are registered with APHA PAC you will need to give GJHSA:

1. A **current** photocopy of your APHA PAC registration card.
2. Photocopy of your APHA horse record.
3. Fill out your exhibitor report form and turn into the show office after each show.
4. Provide GJHSA with your **current** email address

*** Note: It will be the exhibitor's responsibility to understand the current APHA rules and PAC Credit System for filling out the Exhibitors Report. ***

GJHSA will verify that all information on the Exhibitor Report is complete and accurate and email you a signed copy of the record within 10 days. You will need to mail or email the signed Exhibitors Report and a copy of the GJHSA Show Bill to the APHA PAC office within 30 days of the show to receive credits.

For information on the rules of the program you can download a copy of the APHA rulebook from their website. The rules that apply to the PAC program (PR-000) are found on pg. 294 – 300 of the 2013 APHA Rule Book.
